Any beneficial interest in securities of a body where

- a) that body (to your knowledge) has a place of business or land in the area of the Council; and either
 - i. the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £ 25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that body; or
 - ii. if the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which the Relevant Person has a beneficial interest exceeds one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that class.

Definitions

5. 'relevant person' means you as a member of Kington Parish Council or

1. your spouse or civil partner
 - i. a person with whom you are living as husband or wife or
 - ii. a person with whom you are living as if you were civil partners
2. body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest means a firm in which the relevant person is a partner or a body corporate of which the relevant person is a director or in the execution of which the relevant person has a beneficial interest.
3. securities means shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stock, bonds, unit of collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and other securities of any description, other than money deposited with a building society
4. land excludes an easement, servitude, interest or right in or over land which does not carry with it a right for the relevant person (alone or jointly with another) to occupy the land or to receive income.
