Traffic Management
Working Group Terms of Reference

The Working Group is responsible for making recommendations to Full Council on:

- traffic-calming measures that could be implemented to reduce the speed of vehicles through Kniveton.
- measures to reduce traffic noise

Methodology:

1. Establishing a baseline

To review the baseline position prepared by Councillor Barnett to ensure all up to date on the history of previous studies, surveys and correspondence between the Parish Council and Highways, Derbyshire County Council (DCC).

To review the initiatives in the report “Psychological Traffic Calming” prepared for the Traffic Management Division, Department of Transport.

2. Defining Working Group workplan

To seek views of Derbyshire County Councillor on initiatives in other local villages.

To contact Parish/Town Councils that have introduced psychological traffic calming measures to establish the:

- nature of the problem Council was addressing.
- design of their solution
- methodology, implementation, communications
- costs, lessons learnt, best practice, things to avoid.
- success factors and outcomes

3. Agreeing Project for Kniveton

To review data gathered in stages 1 and 2 and agree on possible project(s) for Kniveton.

To discuss suitability of project(s) with Highways, DCC and establish approval requirements.

Consult with residents on projects(s).

4. Proposing Recommendations to Kniveton Parish Council

Presents options to the Council with draft costings and implementation approach.
